SECRETARY'S REPORT AND AUDITED STATMENT OF ACCOUTS OF 'CENTRAL DEWA' FOR THE PERIOD FROM 01-10-2024 TO 30-09-2025 PRESENTED IN THE 'ANNUAL GENERAL BODY MEETING' (AGM) ON 2nd OCTOBER, 2025 (THURSDAY) AT LODHI GARDEN (NEAR LODHI TOMB), NEW DELHI.

On behalf of the 'Executive Committee of Central DEWA', I have great pleasure in welcoming all of you to the 'Annual General Body Meeting' (AGM) of the Association and place before you the report on the various activities of 'Central DEWA' since the last AGM held on 2nd October, 2024.

We heartily bid good bye and best wishes to those members who have gone on promotion or on better prospects elsewhere in India or abroad.

WELCOME

We warmly welcome new members who have been enrolled in 'Central DEWA' during the period under review. We also cordially receive our old members who have come back either on transfer or on promotion from other centres/cities.

ACTIVITIES 3.

- DEWA organised its AGM on 2nd October, 2024, which was successfully conducted as per its Agenda.
- (ii) During the period of one year (01-10-2024 to 30-09-2025), sixty five (65) new members have sought the membership of our Association. This shows that the Association has got adequate popularity among the educated people of the community in and outside Delhi.
- (iii) During the period of one year, eight (08) Executive Committee Meetings were held in which various issues/matters were taken up for discussions and necessary decisions were taken thereon.
- (iv) DEWA organised Sant Gadge Parinirvana Diwas on 20th December, 2024 at 11 am at Shiv Mandir Prangan , VP House, Rafi Marg, New Delhi and heartly tributes (with garlands & flowers on Sant Gadge Statue) were paid by the participants (DEWA EC Members and DPDMS & SMPS etc.) . At the end of the programme, Snacks (Laddu, Samosa & Tea) were served to all the participants.
- (v) Family Get-Together of the community was organised by DEWA on 25-12-2024 in Lodhi Garden (near Lodhi Tomb) in which good number of persons along with their family members participated and enjoyed it in a free and delectable mood. The meritorious students (20 nos. plus) of our community, who secured 70% and above marks in class 10th and 12th exams (in 2024), were awarded 'with a Commendable Certificates and a beautiful Mementos & Medals (including pens as a token of prize) on behalf of Central DEWA'. Besides, an Essay Competition on the Life & Works of Sant Gadge Baba was also organized and out of four students, two students were awarded Cash Prizes of ₹ 1000/- each and remaining two awarded of ₹ 500/- each . Various types of sports/games for boys & girls including ladies (for different age group) were organised and the boys and girls & ladies, getting position in the sports/games held there, were awarded suitable prizes on that day. The Certificates, Mementos/ Medals & Prizes were got distributed through our Senior Members & 'Executive Committee Members' of Central DEWA.
- (vi) Though all the Participants have given their introductions one by one, yet special introductions of the particular families were got done, who participated (in the DEWA Family Get Together) with their marriageable sons & daughters for getting suitable match / Rishta. The Lunch was also served to all the participants in the mid of the 'DEWA Family Get Together Programme'.
- (vii) DEWA also organised a Workshop in the Auditorium of a Vidyalaya at Nehru Nagar, New Delhi (with the collaboration of 'Social Studies Foundation, Pune') for the students & scholars etc of our

community, who were interested to get higher studies (viz., P.G., Ph.D. & Post Doc. etc) in abroad under, National Overseas Scholarships Scheme . In this Workshop, 28 Students & Scholars from our Community had participated and four Faculties from different Universities/IIIT were invited to guide our community Students/Scholars . From this workshop, our students/scholars were benefitted and demands also received by them to organise such workshops again in future. DEWA also arranged the water, Tea & Snacks

(ix) During the year of this report, DEWA has provided a monetary help of ₹ 30,000/- (₹ Thirty Thousand only) to a community brilliant Girl (whose family has no earning member) for admission in LSRCC (Delhi University) in July, 2025. Besides, a Girl Student of our community (admitted in 9th class) was also provided the help in the kind of School Books & Note Books etc by our Chief Patron: Prof. Chhotey Lal Sahab.

(x) DEWA participated in the 'Rajak Rashtriya Adhiveshan' organised by Vishva Rajak Mahasangh (VRM) on 27th July, 2025 at Jaipur (Rajasthan) and also extended a donation of ₹ 5,000/- (₹ Five Thousand only)
